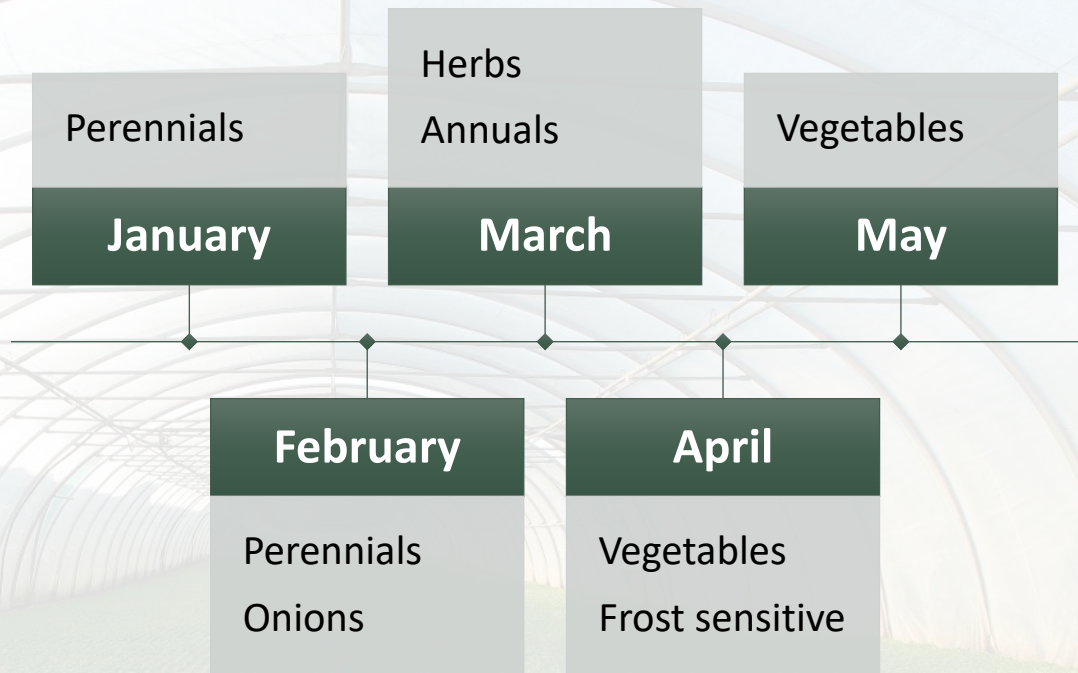

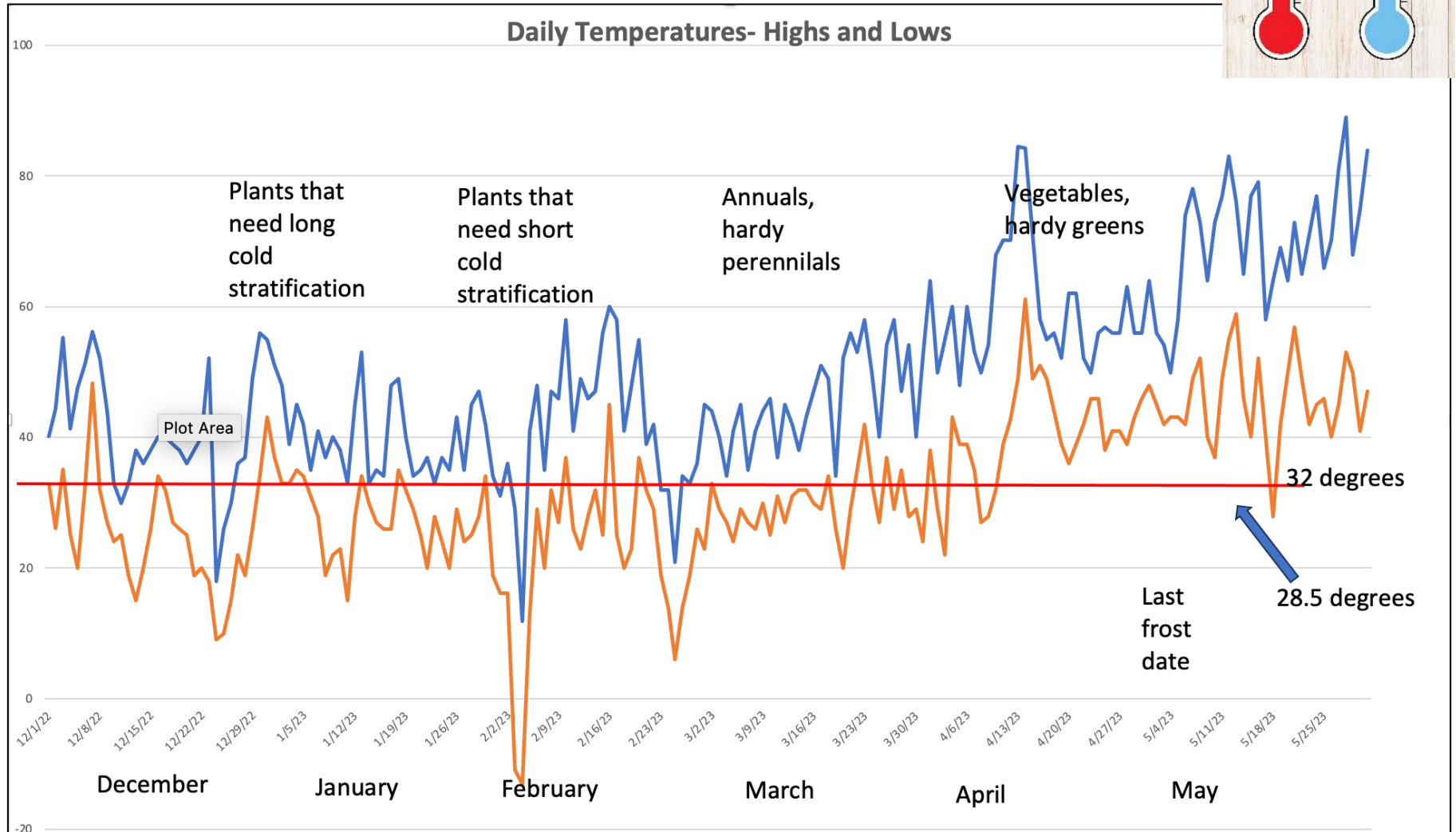
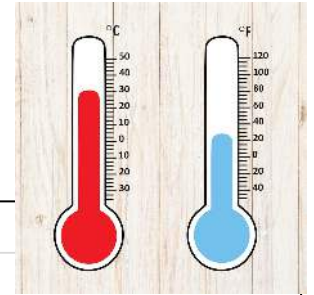

When do I start my seeds?



1. Start seeds AFTER freezing weather is here to stay
2. Plant seeds that require stratification out 4+ weeks BEFORE temps average above freezing.
3. Plant other seeds out 6-8 weeks before transplant date.
